Inc. names fastest-growing companies in NH

A Londonderry company that moves oversize freight ranked as the fastest-growing logistics company in the nation as well as the fastest-growing company in New Hampshire, according to new Inc. Magazine rankings.

Highland Project Logistics saw its revenues grow by 7,904 percent during a three-year period to \$8 million in 2015, landing it Number 23 on the overall Inc. 5000 rank.

Founder Radek Maly is no stranger to the list. A sister company he founded in Londonderry in 1998, Highland Forwarding, made the list seven times, most recently in 2014.

Twenty-three New Hampshire companies landed on this year's list.

Highland Project Logistics, which employs five people at its worldwide head-quarters on Kitty Hawk Landing, focuses on arranging transportation to move oversize cargo.

Topping the logistics rankings "should really help our sales staff in promoting our services," Maly said.

Started five years ago, Highland Project Logistics once arranged for 45 wind-mill blades measuring 180 feet each to be trucked from Colorado to Houston and then shipped by cargo ship to deliver them to the Dominican Republic.

Last year, it shipped a whole gas refinery from Houston to Kazakhstan.
